**Things required- A football, a torch, a piece of string and a tennis ball.**

**Method-** 1. Place the football on a table. It represents Earth(E).

2. Hang the tennis ball, so that it is in line with the football and the torch which represents Sun(S). the tennis ball represents Moon(M).

3. Darken the room. Switch on the torch. Hold the torch, so that tennis ball (or moon) comes between the torch and the football (or Earth).

**When the shadow of the tennis ball (or Moon) falls on the football (or Earth) the eclipse of Sun has taken place.**
