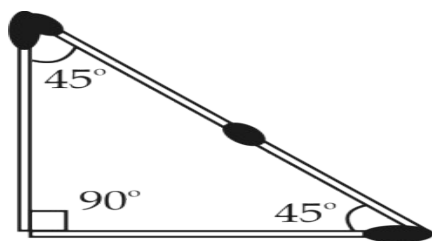

We use the present continuous tense to talk about something that is happening at the time of speaking, often with **now**, **at the moment**, **just**, **today**.

At the moment, they are sipping hot tea.

They are sipping hot tea at the moment.
