<b>COLLECTIVE NOUN</b> A collective noun is the name of a number of person or thing taken together and spoken of as one whole.	<b>ABSTRACT NOUN</b> A noun that denotes some quality, state or action. they cannot be physically touched.
<b>MATERIAL NOUN</b> Things made of matter are called "material things" and names given to them are called material nouns.

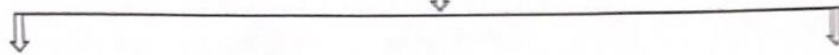

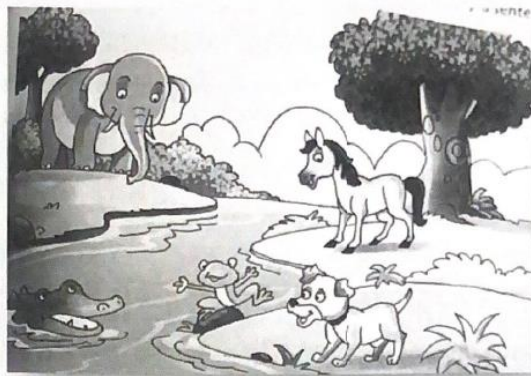

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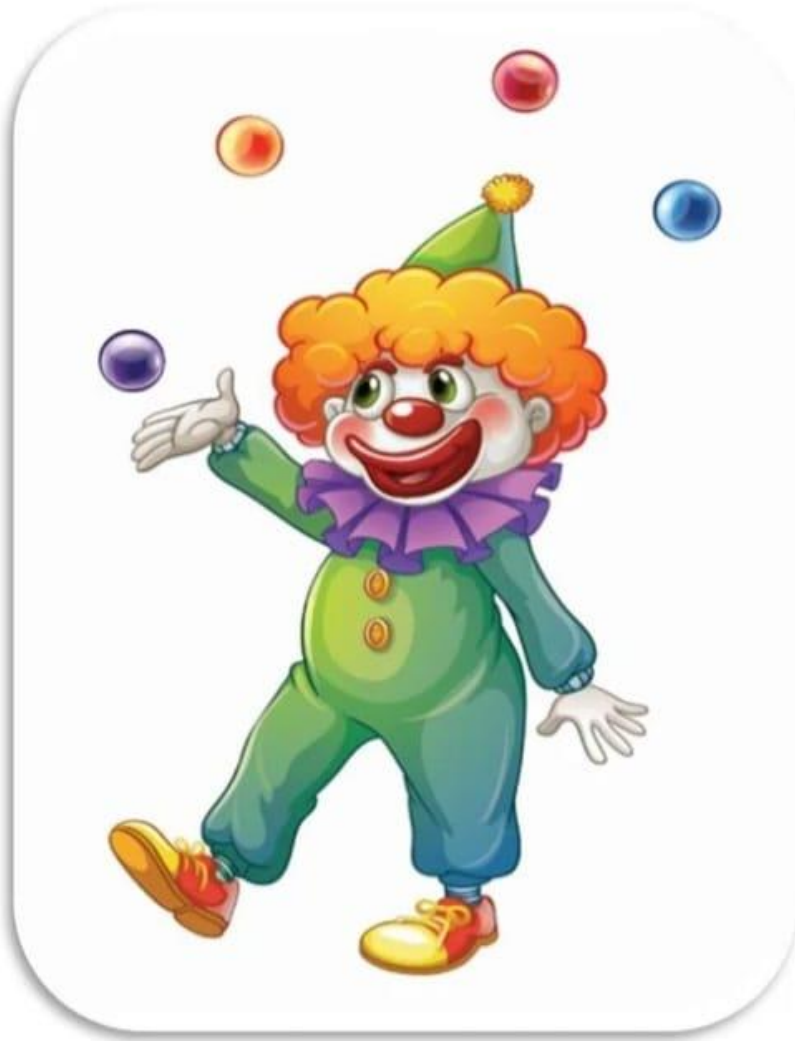
