

Activities Guidelines

What to do:

Language development

- Introduce different story books, picture books to your child and discuss the things seen in the pictures.
- Narrate simple stories to your child and help to recall some characters and incidents of the story by asking simple, relevant questions.
- Encourage your child to speak magic words like 'Thank you', 'Please', 'Excuse me' and 'Sorry'.

Social development

- Encourage your child to converse freely with parents and siblings.
- Encourage your child to help you in laying the table for dinner.
- Guide the child to keep his/her toys and belongings back in their place.
- Plant a garden of herbs and vegetables.
- Encourage him/her to make his/her own cold cereal.
- Arrange for pajama party at home.

How can I become independent:

Make your child more independent by teaching him/her various activities

- Buttoning and Unbuttoning the shirt.
- Zipping and Unzipping.
- Turning pages of book.
- Opening and closing the bottle cap/tiffin lids.
- * Laying the table
- Folding mat and clothes.
- Arranging their toys shelf.
- Learning to wear shoes and socks.
- Learning how to zip their school bag and their uniform shorts.
- Sorting and pairing household items.

As we did cold cooking in our class, prepare something special for your Dad and serve him:


